Parking at the US

There are ninety-one spaces in the student/faculty parking areas. A portion of these spaces are earmarked for student parking, while others are for faculty. There are five or six visitor spots. The cut-out adjacent to this lot holds another 10 or 11 vehicles, but that parking is generally taken by the public. We are not able to restrict them from parking in the cut as it is not owned by the school, but by the Commonwealth. In fact the student/faculty lot is also owned by the Commonwealth but we have an understanding with the Division of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) whereby we use the lot during the week but can make no claim to this area during weekends. Generally this does not conflict with school programs or events as few if any people park there on weekend or even weekday nights.

After drop-off in the morning we also allow visitor parking in the circular driveway by the main entrance, this will accommodate eight or nine vehicles. A third option is the athletic center where we have a parking attendant on duty in the morning to keep unauthorized (students, commuters or hospital affiliates) from parking in this area. In short, there is not a lot of on campus parking so we do what we can, when we can. We do have occasions where some people may park on Greenough Blvd., we do not advise this as the area is posted and the State Police have been known to tag and tow without notice.
