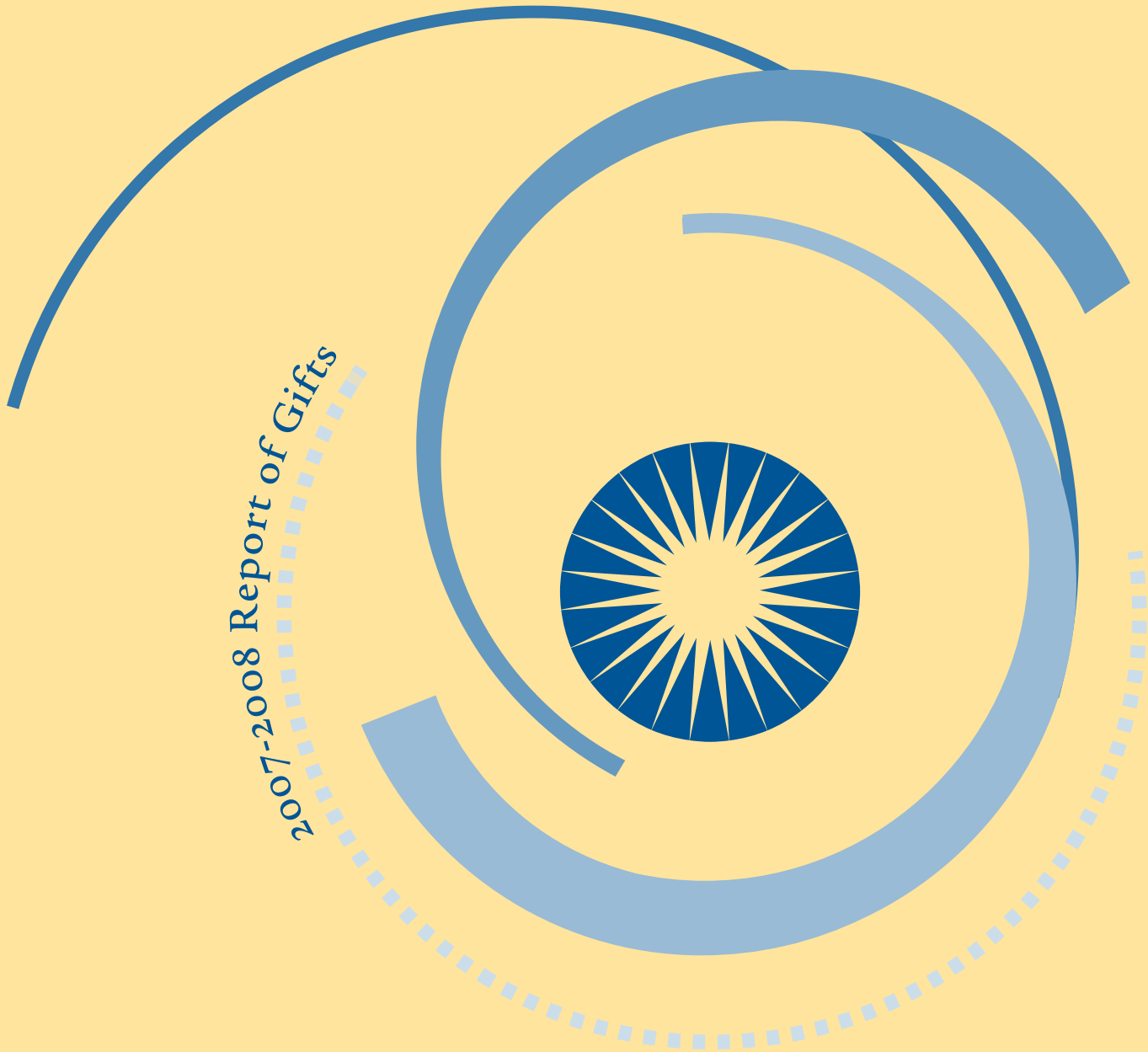

Third Graders Practice Math and Social Skills by Becoming Entrepreneurs

SHEIKA LUC AND ANNA TONRY, THIRD GRADE

One of the strengths of the BB&N academic program is that while it is grounded in the fundamentals, there are many opportunities for teachers to bring creative new ideas and programs into their classrooms. One example at the Lower School for the past two years has been a unit brought to BB&N by third grade teacher Sheika Luc that tests third graders on their math and social skills through creative student-run business projects.

In this unit, students come up with their own businesses and gain knowledge about trading, saving, competition, maintaining a budget, personal relationships, and of course, making change! Notes third grade teacher Anna Tonry, who has worked with Sheika on this unit, “Students are not only asked to practice their money skills, but also are challenged to make difficult decisions and to take risks. The students quickly understand the basics of the business: ‘I have an idea, I need to buy supplies, I need to rent space, I need to make and sell my product, and I need to make enough money to be able to keep my business open.’”

“What the students may not anticipate are the difficulties and setbacks they may encounter along the way. We enjoy reminding students of times throughout the year where we have problem-solved together to come to solutions. The students are extremely self-motivated and feel a great sense of pride and ownership throughout the unit.”

This past year’s businesses included a wide range of products including marker tattoos, shoe fresheners, and one-eyed creatures. The unit also made a stronger connection to the real world by assigning students a range of careers and salaries which led to discussions about decisions and challenges that people face every day.

Anna and Sheika look forward to growing and strengthening the program in future years and welcome suggestions such as that from a Lower School parent to add not-for-profit businesses into the mix.

So look out, world—the BB&N Lower School just might become the incubator for the next great business idea!

Training Future Radio Journalists in a Middle School English Classroom

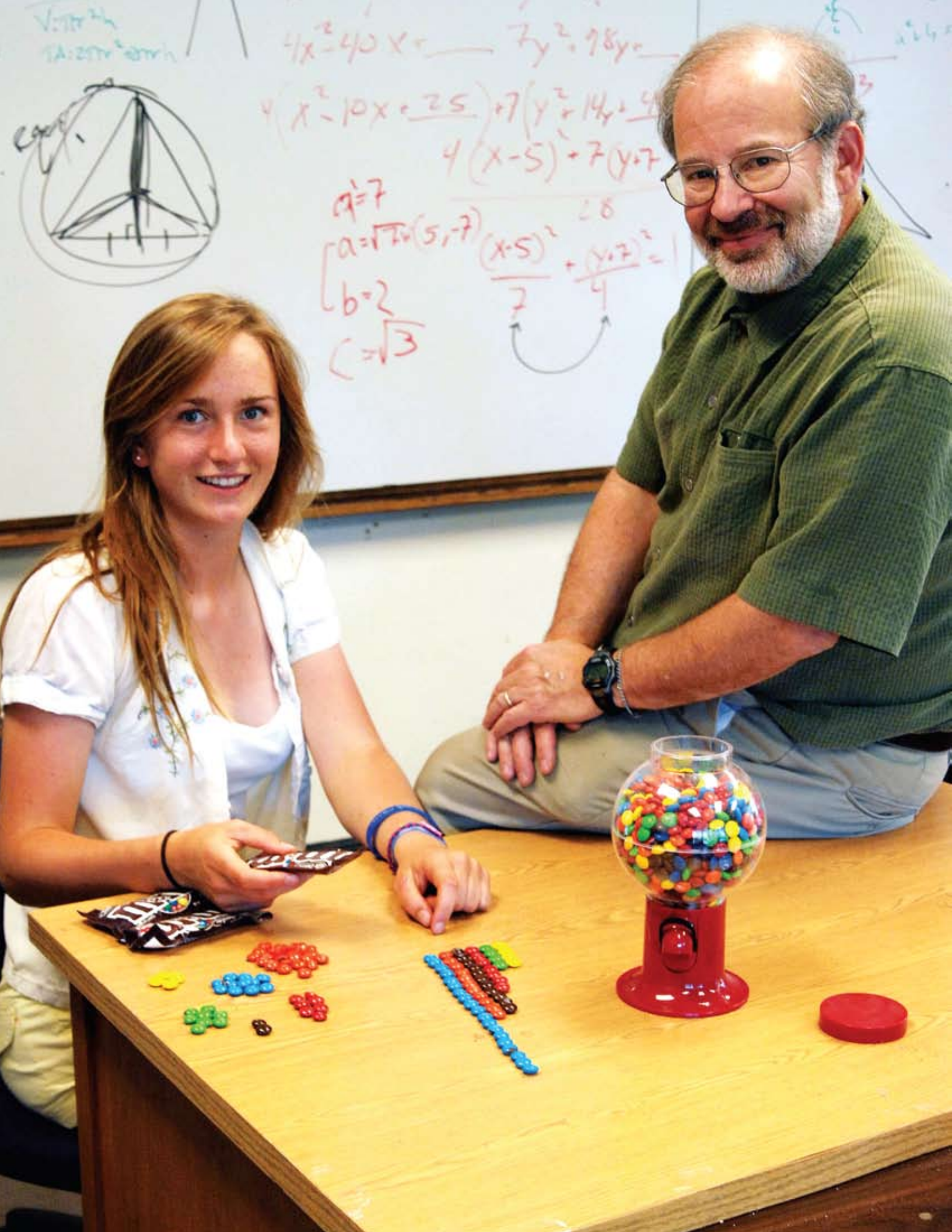
The integration of technology into the classroom has long been a priority at BB&N, supported by the School's professional development and technology budgets, and the eagerness of BB&N faculty to find appropriate ways to take advantage of students' comfort with technology in order to reinforce academic objectives.

Middle School faculty member Rachel Jamison is one of those at the forefront of such initiatives. "In my work as a Middle School English teacher, I have had the opportunity and support to research and experiment with methods of incorporating the technology that surrounds and sometimes consumes our students. In doing so, I have examined my own discipline through a technology lens to generate a solution to the question lingering over pedagogy these days—how do we, as educators, address, acknowledge, and embrace the ever-evolving idea of 'literacy.' The Radio Essay unit effectively addresses the literacy discussion, as this project seamlessly incorporates an exciting multimedia technology project into our seventh grade English curriculum."

The Radio Essay unit serves as the culmination of the year-long English curriculum theme of Portraits, and combines the autobiographical writing concepts of the Family Portrait Sketchbook and the creative memoir narratives of *The House on Mango Street*. To bridge the gap between those units, students explore the genre of creative non-fiction through readings, recorded examples, and class discussions.

Once students distinguish the difference between stories to be read and stories to be listened to, they rewrite a Sketchbook piece or compose a totally new narrative to record as a three- to five-minute Radio Essay. Students rehearse and record their own piece, then use GarageBand software to edit their recording, mix the story with sound effects and/or music, and produce their digital narrative into an MP3 file or a Podcast.

BB&N Continues to Pioneer New Concepts in Statistics Education

AL COONS, UPPER SCHOOL MATH

What do M&Ms have to do with statistics, you may ask? Everything, says Upper School math and statistics teacher Al Coons. Twelve years ago, Coons started BB&N's and one of the country's first Advanced Placement Statistics course which now attracts more than 100,000 students nationwide.

"What makes BB&N's course unique," notes Coons, "is that we use a book called *Workshop Statistics* which uses a totally activity-based, student-centered, experimental approach to the subject. Students learn by doing their own experiments, explore concepts with their own data rather than using a set of formulae, and reach their own conclusions.

"By having technology replace inappropriate drudgery often found in traditional statistics courses, we can focus on the higher-level concepts behind the formulae. Students are expected to be able to explain what the traditional statistical measures and formulae represent rather than simply computing answers. In fact, most problems involve as much writing as computation."

While students often complain that they see little connection between their math classes and what they will be doing in their daily life, they quickly see the connections with statistics. Notes Coons, "Students need a basic literacy in statistics in order to understand and evaluate the increasing use of statistical reporting to describe our world and to try to influence opinions."

Over the past year, BB&N has introduced a new program, Statistics Across the Curriculum, the goal of which is to enable all Upper School graduates to gain just such a basic literacy in statistics. Designed in the summer of 2007 through professional development funding, the initial curriculum was piloted last year by integrating statistics into existing math classes, and is being further developed this year.

So how does all this relate to M&Ms? Very simple, says Coons. "In the first statistics class, each student is given a bag of M&Ms and I ask them to organize the colors to help us understand their distribution. It begins our study of the fundamental idea of statistics, variation, and leads to a discussion of how various ways of organizing data each provide useful information. Throughout the course, instead of only focusing on the numerical outcome of computations, they are constructing their own knowledge base and discussing the advantages and disadvantages of different approaches to the same topic."

And an even greater reward? They get to eat their data at the end of the class!

New Upper School Art and Performance Spaces Transform Teaching and Learning

With the opening of the new Upper School campus in September 2007, BB&N has entered a new era in providing exceptional facilities for our students and faculty that equal the top quality academic programs for which BB&N has always been known. Parrish Dobson, Chair of the Upper School Arts Department and photography teacher, played a leadership role in organizing faculty input into the design of the new visual and performing arts studios which grace the second and third floor of Renaissance Hall. Reflecting back on the past year, she noted a number of ways in which the new spaces have truly allowed the Upper School arts program to flourish.

“Last year began with the palpable excitement of moving into our new visual arts and music facilities. Finally, we have the spaces that reflect the high caliber of the faculty and the programs we offer in the arts at BB&N. In the visual arts, the studios were hopping. The more spacious and more inviting spaces were magnets for students. Classes were full, and students came to the studios in their free time. This is exactly what we were hoping would happen.

“We also had our first year of the new Petropoulos Art Scholars Program, a program of co-curricular visual arts events for interested students. Events included field trips, visiting artists showing their work, and in-house workshops in techniques outside of the normal curriculum. The program was a great success and will continue this year.

“In the performing arts we kicked off last year with the first-ever Cabaret Night, an evening featuring student, faculty, and alumni/ae singers in our new Choral room, and we continued this new tradition this fall. The new space makes such events possible, with performance lighting and comfortable seating in an elegant and acoustically outstanding setting.

“In the renovated theater, we had a full season of professional-level productions including Shakespeare’s *All’s Well that Ends Well*, Sondheim’s *Anyone Can Whistle*, and Van Italy’s *A Fable*. The selection of plays, costumes, and innovations with set design, lighting, and sound made each performance an intellectually challenging, aesthetic, and engaging experience.

“This year’s program of gallery exhibits has gotten off to an exciting start with an installation of a ‘Drawing Lab’ created by artist Deborah Putnoi in the Lower Art Gallery, followed by an Upper School Arts Faculty show in November and student work in December. BB&N’s commitment to the arts, demonstrated in our fine new spaces, has helped the entire student, faculty, and parent community recognize the central role of the arts in the lives of young people—now and for years to come.”

The Annual Fund is BB&N's annual fund-raising program with a goal of raising funds necessary to bridge the gap in the operating budget created between tuition and the actual cost of a BB&N education. It guarantees the continued tradition of excellence that defines BB&N.

2007-2008 FUND-RAISING AND DEVELOPMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- **Opening Minds Campaign tops \$54.4 million** in total support for endowment, capital projects, and Annual Giving at the end of the third year of the public phase of the Campaign.
- **Annual Fund reaches its \$2.35 million goal** in total annual operating support with gifts from nearly 1,700 donors.
- **\$1 million Alumni/ae Challenge**—to match all new gifts of \$25,000 or more from new alumni/ae donors—**exceeds its goal**, with 31 alumni/ae from the classes of 1935 to 1998 making qualifying gifts and pledges totaling \$1,455,000.
- **Class of 2008 Senior Parents raise \$930,593** for faculty endowment, annual gifts, and other capital projects, with 99% participation.
- **Upper School Building and Renovation Project**, a major capital priority of the Opening Minds Campaign, **opens on time and on budget** in September 2007, with the official Opening Doors building dedication on September 29, 2007 and the naming of Renaissance Hall.

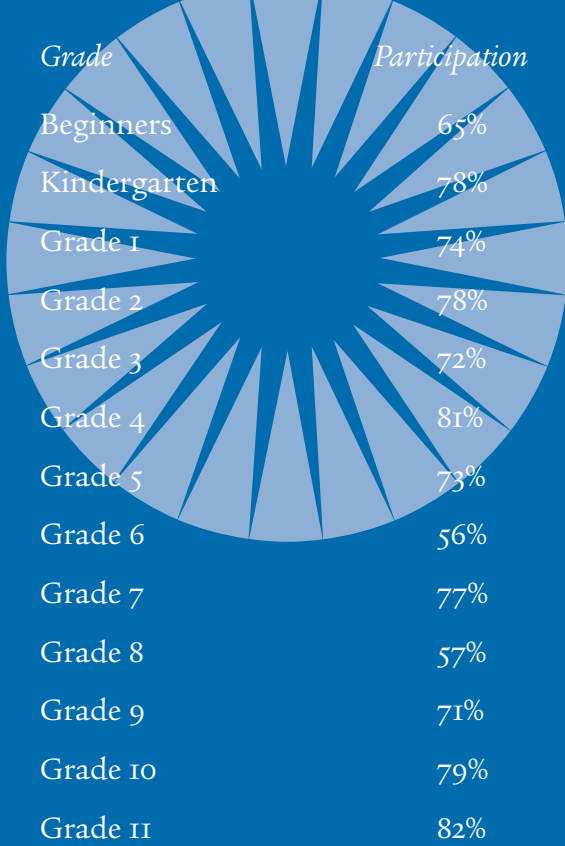

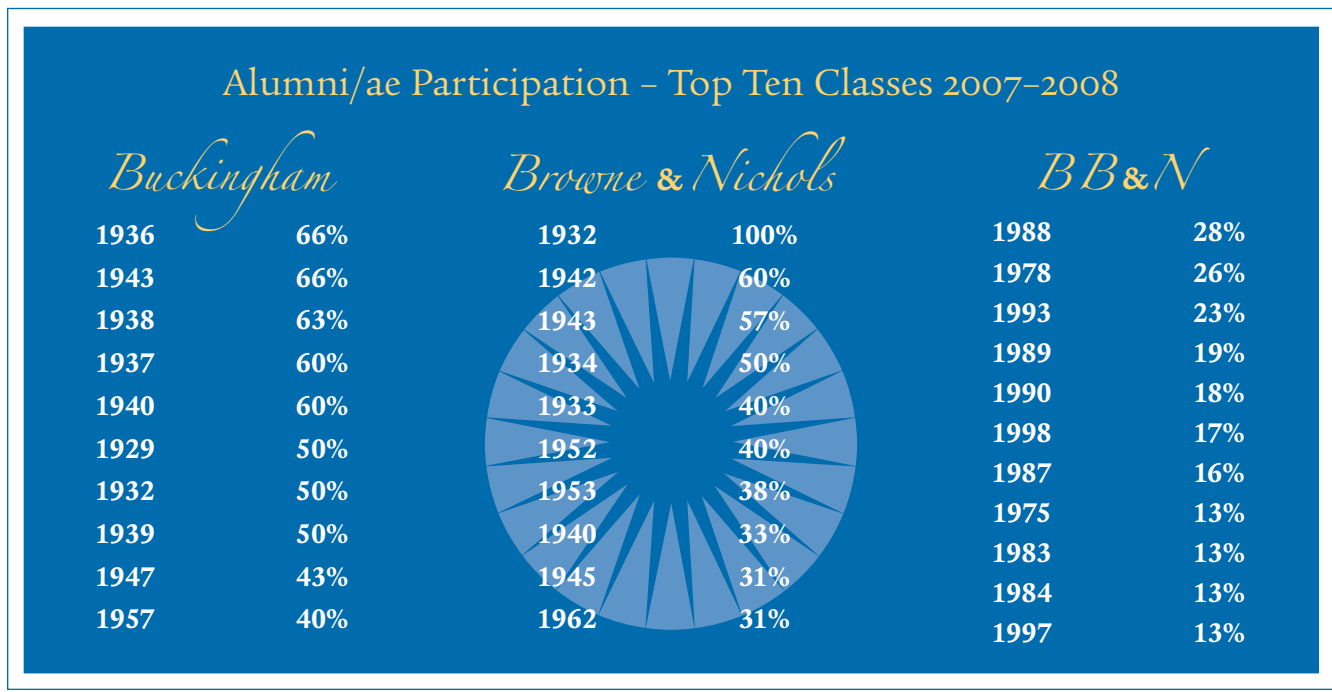

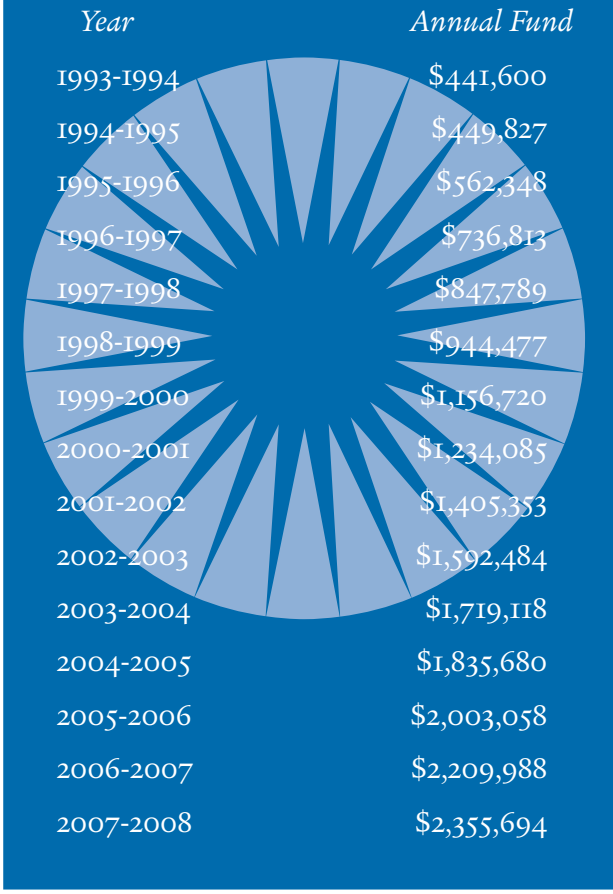

“If you value student-centered critical thinking, there is no more effective method than Harkness,” says Upper School English teacher Alda Farlow, who learned the art of Harkness teaching at her previous institution. “We have very bright children here and they can learn from each other.” Both physically and philosophically, the Harkness table creates a classroom dynamic where every student is on equal footing with his/her classmates, and with the teacher. “When students can face each other, literally sharing a table co-equally,” says Farlow, “they can exchange ideas and reflect on them with an interpersonal understanding not always possible in other environments.”

BB&N Endowment and Spendable Funds



The BB&N endowment is comprised of more than 130 named and general endowed funds, the income from which supports approximately 5% of BB&N's operating budget each year.

Established through both outright gifts and bequests by alumni/ae, parents, and friends with a vision for BB&N's future, these funds provide the long-term financial support necessary to sustain many areas of the BB&N operating budget, from faculty compensation, professional development, and financial aid to academic and athletic programs.

The following list describes many of BB&N's current endowment and spendable funds and the areas of the budget they support. Those funds created during 2007-08 are highlighted below.

GENERAL/ UNRESTRICTED ENDOWMENT

“This is the third year that BB&N has offered a course in Arabic, making it one of only a handful of secondary schools in the U.S. to do so. In light of recent developments and the strained relationship between the U.S. and the Middle East, the cultural aspects of the class have proved to be just as important as the language itself. In order to successfully change how we perceive people in other parts of the world (not just the Arab world), and vice versa, we must focus on the commonalities that we have rather than the differences.”

Anne Elliott Smith Math Faculty Development Fund

This fund honors the memory of a beloved and distinguished Middle School mathematics teacher, Anne Elliott Smith. The fund provides support for curriculum development in mathematics or related studies with a preference for faculty and programs at the Middle School.

Alexandra and Ben Trustman Financial Aid Fund

Established in 2001 by a BB&N grandparent in honor of her two BB&N grandchildren, this fund is used to support the general financial aid program with a strong preference for assisting an African-American student and a slight preference for a Lower School African-American student.

The Mildred and Clarence Williams Financial Aid Fund

Established in 2007 by Clarence G. Williams, Jr. '85 and his wife Joanne Taylor, the Mildred and Clarence Williams Fund is named in honor of Clarence's parents. The Fund supports the general financial aid program of BB&N with a preference for supporting an Upper School inner city student of color and preferably a student who entered BB&N in the Lower or Middle School.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS**Asian Studies Endowment Fund**

Established in 1999, this fund supports faculty salaries and program expenses related to the Chinese or other Asian language studies program.

Maureen Baker Lower School Language Arts Fund

Established in 2004 by a group of Lower School parents to honor Maureen Baker, a Lower School teacher at The Buckingham School and BB&N from 1964 to 2004, the Baker Fund supports the Lower School language arts program with a preference for Morse Building (Beginner, Kindergarten, and Grade 1) students. Uses for the fund include support for a poet-in-residence, a visiting author or illustrator specializing in writing for younger students, or professional development in the language arts for Morse Building faculty.

Larry Cabot Fund for Girls' Crew

Established in 2000 in honor of long-time faculty member and girls' crew coach Larry Cabot, this fund supports the program expenses of the girls' crew program.

Class of 1987 Audio Visual Fund

Established in honor of the graduating students in the Class of 1987, this fund is used to support current and future needs of the audiovisual program at the Upper School.

Class of 1988 International Fund

Established in honor of graduating students in the Class of 1988, this fund supports international education at BB&N by providing study and travel opportunities for students and faculty; curriculum expansion in international studies, including foreign languages; or bringing internationally renowned speakers to the School.

Class of 1989 Art Fund

Established in honor of graduating students in the Class of 1989, this fund supports all aspects of the art program at BB&N and may be used for faculty enrichment, visiting artists, speakers, curriculum development, cultural activities, travel, or special equipment.

Class of 1990 Science Fund

Established in honor of graduating students in the Class of 1990, this fund supports the teaching of science at BB&N.

Comitas Fund – Lower School

Established in 1996 through an anonymous gift, this fund provides program support to promote anti-bias, gender-fair curriculum and seminars, the hiring of faculty of color, and diversity and gender equity training at the Lower School.

Comitas Fund – Middle School

Established in 2000, this fund provides program support to promote anti-bias, gender-fair curriculum and seminars, the hiring of faculty of color, and diversity and gender equity training at the Middle School.

George Deptula Russian Program Enrichment Fund

Established in 1995 by the Dangel family in honor of former Russian History teacher George Deptula P'66, this fund enriches the programs of the Russian Department by supporting the acquisition of resource materials, underwriting visits by distinguished guest speakers, and providing financial assistance to enable students of Russian to travel and participate in special programs.

James Ducey Book Fund

Established in 1986 by J. Richard Hunneman, Jr. '42, this fund supports the purchase of books and periodicals in science, technology, and applied sciences.

English Seminar Learning Fund

Established in 1997, this fund was established in honor of Jane Clark, former Middle School teacher and Academic Skills Coordinator. The fund supports BB&N programs that directly benefit students and accommodate their learning styles, with a preference for programs for 7th and 8th grade students.

Fesus Girls' Crew Fund

Established in 1993 by Mr. and Mrs. George J. Fesus P'90, '93, this fund supports the girls' crew program.

Fraulein Grote Fund for German Culture

This fund supports Middle or Upper School department expenses related to German culture, literature, and history.

Hintlian Library Art Book Fund

This fund was established in 1987 by Ann Hintlian in honor of her daughter LuAnn Hintlian Ohanian '73, and is used to purchase books on the arts for the Upper School library.

Hodder Lecture Fund

Established in 1998 by colleagues and friends, this fund honors the contributions of Elizabeth D. Hodder P'80, '82, '85, '87 to the Upper School during her eight-year tenure as Dean of Students. The fund supports a program to bring to the School a recognized artist, athlete, scholar, or leader to meet with classes, give workshops, and/or speak at an All-School assembly.

Hoyt Family Library Endowment Fund

Established in 2003 through the trust of Natalie Hoyt, this fund is named in memory of her brothers Barrett Hoyt '26 and Harrison Hoyt '34. The income from this fund is used for the purchase of books for the BB&N libraries.

The Legacy Foreign Language Fund

The Legacy Foreign Language Fund was established by Eleanor Campbell '76 to enhance the objectives of the language program on all three campuses. Uses of the Fund include special programs for language students both in and out of the classroom, the cost of classroom materials, and expenses related to other areas that would enhance the teaching and learning of these languages, particularly the strategy of "immersing" students in the language that they are studying.

Lower School Reading Fund

Established in 1999, the Lower School Reading Fund supports the "special needs" portion of the Lower School reading program by accommodating students' learning styles as readers.

Anna Minot Warren Theater Production Fund

Established in 2006 by Anna Minot Warren '35, a lifelong professional actor who helped establish the Buckingham drama program, this fund provides income to help underwrite the annual production costs of the Upper School Drama Program including such expenses as costume purchase or rental, set materials, script and music rental, lighting supplies, and royalties.

Pechet Family Book Fund

The Pechet Fund is used for the purchase of books for BB&N's libraries.

Petropoulos Art Scholars Program Fund

The Petropoulos Art Scholars Program Fund represents a new direction for the Petropoulos Art Prize Fund, originally established in 1983 by Andre Balazs '75 and Peter Gergely '72 in memory of John B. Petropoulos P'93, a beloved member of the Browne & Nichols and BB&N Upper School Art Department faculty from 1962 to 1982. The Petropoulos Art Scholars Program provides an enriched experience for Upper School students who participate in independent study programs in the visual arts.

Saunders Family Fitness Center Equipment Fund

Established in 1999 through gifts from Gary and Barbara Saunders P'00, '04 and Jeffrey and Debra Saunders P'03, this fund supports the purchase of replacement equipment for the Fitness Center in the Nicholas Athletic Center.

The Sixth Grade Endowment Fund for Student Enrichment

This fund was established in 2007 by parents in the Class of 2013 to enhance and enrich the learning opportunities for Lower School students through supplemental programs in the arts, sciences, or other academic areas.

Reeves Stratton Science Fund

Established in 1980 by Browne & Nichols alumni from classes that graduated in the mid-1940s, this fund honors the memory of B&N faculty members James Arthur Reeves and

Charles Edward Stratton. The fund supports the purchase of reference materials for the Upper School library, provides materials for the Science Department, and supports faculty professional development.

Marjorie Thompson Fund

Established in 1989 by family and friends in memory of Marjorie Thompson to honor her contributions and devotion to the School during the many years she served as Director of Development, this fund provides support for the Head's Discretionary Fund.

The Upper School Critical Languages Program Fund

Established in 2006 by an anonymous donor, this fund honors Upper School Language Department Chair Armen Dedekian, a distinguished member of the BB&N language faculty from 1971 to 2008, who played a crucial role in strengthening and expanding BB&N's nationally known Russian language program. The Fund provides program support for the teaching of non-traditional and less commonly taught languages including the currently taught languages of Russian, Chinese, and Arabic, with a preference for program support for Russian.

John H. "Doc" Walters Fund

Established in 1999 in memory of long-time Upper School science teacher Doc Walters P'68, '70, this fund supports the purchase of equipment, professional development for science faculty, and other ongoing expenses of the Upper School Science Department.

BB&N SPENDABLE FUNDS

The funds listed below provide spendable resources to support a variety of School priorities including financial aid, faculty compensation, and academic support initiatives.

Eric Benke Drug and Alcohol Awareness Fund

Established in 2005 by the Upper School Parents' Association, this fund honors Eric Benke, Director of the BB&N Upper School from 2000–2005, and his work with and for Upper School students, particularly his efforts to ensure their safety regarding drug and alcohol use. The Benke Fund is used to support additional drug and alcohol programs developed under the direction of the Upper School Counselor.

The Jenny Fiol Birch 1987 Financial Aid Fund

The Jenny Birch Fund was established by alumni/ae and friends of the Class of 1987 in memory of Jenny Fiol Birch '87. This spendable fund honors Jenny's cherished experience in Italy during her Junior year and is intended to assist BB&N financial aid students' expenses for the School's study abroad program.

Community Family Fund

Established in 2001 by a group of BB&N parents in response to the events of September 11, 2001, this fund provides support to current BB&N families in immediate need of tuition assistance following the death of a parent.

The Community Supplemental Financial Aid Fund

The Community Supplemental Financial Aid Fund was established in 2008 by a current BB&N family to provide support for non-tuition expenses (such as books, academic and athletic trips, and computers for home use) for students receiving financial assistance from the School.



HIGH LIGHT ON TEACHING

Maggie Caso Upper School Spanish

Upper School Spanish teacher Maggie Caso raves about her experience in the summer of 2007 as part of a program that "educated educators" about service learning. The trip, sponsored by the Vermont-based organization LiveLearning, sent teachers to the Dominican Republic where they participated in service learning workshops at the Centro Regional Estudios de Alternativas Rurales. The teachers were trained in sustainable agriculture—learning skills that Caso brought back to the BB&N campus as she and several students started a small garden in front of the Wood Shop on the Upper School campus. Caso continued the relationships with LiveLearning and the Dominican Republic by traveling back to the country with BB&N students for the Spanish trip in June.



The Albert Coons Curriculum Development Fund

The Albert Coons Curriculum Development Fund was established in 2008 through a gift from Richard Mulligan P'10 in recognition of Upper School math faculty member Al Coons' excellence in teaching. This spendable fund will be used to further develop the AP Statistics course, to stimulate the possible future development of additional courses in statistics, and to provide support for other innovative curriculum development activities at BB&N.

The Covington Family History Globalization Fund

Established by Bonnie and Chris Covington P'05, '08 in honor of Upper School faculty member Louise Makrauer in appreciation of her excellence in teaching Upper School history, the Covington Fund is a spendable fund intended to support the Upper School History and Social Sciences Department faculty in their efforts to revise existing courses and build new courses that further the department's commitment to the "globalization" of the curriculum.

The Armen Dedekian Russian Program Fund

The Armen Dedekian Russian Program Fund was established in 2007 by Michael Porter P'06, '07 in appreciation of the strong impact that the Russian program has had on students at BB&N and in honor of his daughter Sonia '07's experience in the program during her time at BB&N. This spendable fund is intended to provide income to support expenses of the Russian program not covered by the department's operating budget, such as costs associated with developing new programs or other expenses outside the normal classroom program.



HIGH LIGHT ON TEACHING

Betsy Canaday Middle School English

“For three weeks every fall, seventh grade English students find themselves doing something quite unexpected in an English classroom. They spend most of their class time observing slides of visual portraits. Careful, thoughtful, energetic observation leads to interesting, imaginative insights, and we ask students to be clear, thorough, and precise in their thinking. This requires that we do something countercultural: we slow down. What students come to realize is that we are practicing literary analysis by studying visual art rather than by reading a written text. They hone their close reading skills by observing, making inferences about and analyzing visual portraits.”



The John R. Glick '88 Theater Fund

The John R. Glick '88 Theater Fund was established in 2008 by alumni/ae and friends of the BB&N Class of 1988 in memory of John Glick '88 on the occasion of the class's 20th reunion. The fund honors John's deep love of the arts, music, and theater during his time at BB&N and in his professional and personal life until his untimely death in 2005. This spendable fund is intended to provide supplemental funds to the Upper School Theater Program to be used for program needs identified by the Upper School Theater Director.

Bartlett M. Hawthaway Scholarship Fund

Established in 2001 by Bartlett M. Hawthaway '42, this fund provides a full scholarship annually for one or more Upper School students of good character who are strongly motivated, intellectually or artistically promising, able to cooperate, eager to lead or create, and who have a deep and abiding interest in nature.

Inavale Foundation Financial Aid Fund

This gift provides a full scholarship to a deserving Upper School student.

The Kinasewich Senior Speakers Program Fund

The Kinasewich Fund was initiated by Chris Mosca '75 in 2007 to honor the memory of Gene Kinasewich who served as a member of the faculty, a coach, and class dean from 1973 to 1977. This spendable fund supports a guest speaker program for BB&N Seniors to help them address issues they face as they leave BB&N.

Lower School Faculty Training Program Fund

Established in 2003 by Ethel Marran GP'12, this fund supports BB&N's efforts to recruit and train young teaching professionals who will increase the diversity of the Lower School faculty and direct the After School Study Skills Program at the Lower School.

Past Parents' Financial Aid Fund

Established in 1999 by parents of BB&N graduates, this spendable fund provides financial aid for an Upper School student.

Al Rossiter Child Development Faculty Support Fund

Established in 1999, this fund supports the further understanding of child and adolescent development and mental health issues throughout the School community.

Upper School Visiting Writers Fund

The Upper School Visiting Writers Fund was established in 2002 by a group of Upper School parents to enhance the writing component of the Upper School English curriculum by inviting distinguished authors, poets, and other writers to BB&N to work with and give presentations for Upper School students and faculty.
