



Winter Exam Information

Monday, December 11, 2017 – Friday, December 15, 2017

Exam Logistics and Policies

1. At least the last two class periods and corresponding homework assignments preceding exams are devoted to review. Review Days start with C and F Blocks on Wednesday, December 6. On these days, no tests, quizzes, lab, or papers will be due and no new material will be introduced. In addition, each teacher holds a review session on the afternoon preceding the exam (generally 1:00 – 3:00 p.m.).
2. Students should check the exam schedule posted in the Commons for the exact day and time of each exam. In general, exams occur on the following days:

Monday, December 11 – English Exam

Tuesday, December 12 – Mathematics Exam

Wednesday, December 13 – Science Exam

Thursday, December 14 – World Languages Exam

Friday, December 15 – History and Social Sciences Exam; AP Statistics Exam

Students with a conflict (two or more exams at the same time in Mathematics and Computer Science, Science, and/or World Languages) are notified by email of their specific exam schedule.

3. Exams are administered from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. each day in the Nicholas Athletic Center. Extended time exams end at 12:00 p.m. Students should report to the exam location no later than 15 minutes before the exam is scheduled to begin.
4. Jackets, bags, and hats should not be brought into the testing area. Students are permitted to bring a bottle of water into the testing area, but should not bring other food or drink with them.
5. During the exam, there should be no talking or communicating with other students. In addition, students should not have access to any material that might be useful on the exam unless by specific permission of the instructor.
6. Cell phones and other electronic devices (other than approved calculators) should remain outside of the exam room or be placed in the designated area at the front of the exam room.
7. During the exam, students may not leave the exam room except in an emergency and only with the proctor's permission.
8. Students who finish the exam early will not be permitted to leave the testing area for the first 90 minutes of the exam. At the 90-minute mark, students who are finished will be given an opportunity to exit the exam room. After the 105-minute mark, all students will be expected to remain in the exam room until the end of the exam (120 minutes). Students previously approved for extended time will be allowed one extra hour to complete the exam.
9. Lunch will be available each day from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
10. Normal bus route service (morning and afternoon) will continue throughout the week.
11. Continuous shuttle service between the Upper School and DCR Parking Lot #4 will be available throughout each day.

Delays or Closings due to Inclement Weather: Information about delays or closings due to inclement weather will be relayed to families through automated phone messages, the School website (www.bbns.org), and local news channels, generally by 6:00 a.m. each day.

Delays

- If school is delayed on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, the exam will occur on the afternoon of the same day (1:00 – 3:00 p.m.).
- If school is delayed on Friday, the exam will occur on the afternoon of the same day (1:00 – 3:00 p.m.) for students that are not scheduled to play in the athletics tournaments taking place at that time. Students who participate in tournaments will take the exam at the first opportunity that weekend.

School Closing

- If school is closed on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, the exam will occur the following afternoon (1:00 – 3:00 p.m.). For example, if school is closed on Monday, Monday's exam will occur on Tuesday afternoon.
- If school is closed on Thursday, the exam will occur the following afternoon (1:00 – 3:00 p.m.) for students that are not scheduled to play in the athletics tournaments taking place at that time. Students who participate in tournaments will take the exam at the first opportunity that weekend.
- If school is closed on Friday, the exam will occur on the morning of Saturday, December 17 (9:00 – 11:00 a.m.)
