Goal of The BB&N Fund Volunteer Committee:

To educate parents regarding the value of philanthropy at BB&N, raise awareness of the critical role of The BB&N Fund, and assist the school in reaching financial and participation goals in parent and alumni/ae support in FY19.

Mission of The BB&N Fund:

The BB&N Fund is the School's Annual Fund – a primary source of income accounting for over 7% of the School's operating budget each year. All parents and alumni/ae are welcomed to participate in a thoughtful manner with financial gifts that are meaningful to them. This support enhances the lives of the students, faculty, and facilities across all three campuses and helps sustain the tradition of academic excellence for which BB&N is known.

BB&N accepts gifts to support needs across all three campuses, including academic programs, all athletic and art programming, financial aid, faculty compensation and professional development, and improvements to the physical plant. For the purpose of crediting gifts, the Fund coincides with the School's fiscal year (July 1 - June 30). Combined with income from BB&N's endowment and tuition revenue (which covers only 80% of the cost of a BB&N education) the Fund is vital in making continued excellence possible.

The BB&N Fund Volunteer Committee Description:

The BB&N Fund Volunteer Committee is headed by an Executive Committee that includes two Co-Chairs, Parent Participation Chair, Parent Leadership Chair, Parent Engagement Chair and a Campus Chair for each campus – Lower School, Middle School, and Upper School as well as an Alumni/ae 1974 Leadership Society Chair, Young Alumni/ae 1974 Leadership Society Chair, Alumni/ae Participation Chair, and an Alumni/ae Engagement Chair. This group is supported by the Director of the BB&N Fund, who works with the Executive Committee to ensure that annual financial goals are achieved.

The BB&N Fund Volunteer Executive Committee, in collaboration with the BB&N Fund Team, works with Parent Grade Captains that are recruited for each grade. Grade Captains receive assignments and collaborative support from members of The BB&N Fund Team over the course of the year.

Together, the Executive Committee and Grade Captains educate, inspire, and support other parents and alumni/ae in making their participation in The BB&N Fund a part of their BB&N experience. In general, the entire Committee meets twice a year – once in the Fall for training and once in the Spring for the year end update. The Executive Committee meets in the Fall, Winter, and Spring to receive updates and discuss strategies to bring the year to a successful close. Each Executive Committee Member/Grade Captain will receive bi-weekly updates from The BB&N Fund team to provide timely updates regarding assignments.
