BB&N participates in a Safe House Program, used by many other schools and towns around the country. The program is designed to empower parents and guardians to create a safe environment for their children and their children's friends by setting clear expectations about drug and alcohol use in their homes as well as access to firearms or prescription drugs.

Fill out the attached form to join the Safe House Program. This agreement is viewed as a means of promoting safety, health, and open communication among BB&N families and students.

By filling out the form, you are pledging:

- Not to serve or allow minors to consume alcohol or other drugs in your home.
- To secure any firearms and prescription drugs to assure that no students will have access during the gathering.
- To actively supervise any parties that take place in your home.
- To be open to communication with other parents in an effort to create a safer community for our children.

A list of families participating in the Safe House Program is posted on the BB&N Parents Portal (with password protection). Families on the Safe House list will remain there unless the family requests removal in writing.

SAFE HOUSE PROGRAM AGREEMENT

The Safe House Program is an agreement signed by BB&N parents/guardians. The agreement states that if their child hosts a gathering in their home, apartment, second home, or office, a parent or guardian will be present to chaperone the gathering and will not allow any drugs or alcoholic beverages to be served to minors on the premises. In addition, the parent/guardian will secure any firearms and prescription drugs to assure that no students will have access during the gathering. This agreement is viewed as a means of promoting safety, health, and open communication among BB&N parents and students.

Signing below indicates that families on the Safe House list will remain there unless the family requests removal in writing. I/We will supervise any student gathering held in our home, second home, apartment, or office and will not allow student consumption of alcohol or drugs at any of our property or on our premises.

I/We further agree that any firearms in our home, second home, apartment, or office shall be unloaded and locked securely away from the students and that I/we will assure that no students have access to these firearms at any time during a party or gathering.
