In order to ensure adherence to these rules, we reserve the right to inspect a student's luggage upon their arrival at Bivouac.

We realize that in today's highly interconnected culture, the experience of being disconnected may cause concern for some students or parents. For this reason, we want to remind you that in any type of emergency, parents may contact the School, who can relay messages to David Strodel, Bivouac Director. Please also know that in extenuating circumstances, arrangements can be made with the Bivouac Director for a parent/guardian to be in contact with a student.
