TYPING Necessary at BB&N ?

Few skills are more necessary than basic typing. Whether we like it or not, it affects homework speed and accuracy, and even our email communication. Typed homework means having a record of your work saved, being legible, and the ability to spell check and correct, so most teachers require it often or all the time.

Most kids at BB&N find that typing 30 words a minute, reasonably accurately, is a foundation for academic success and helps to keep the stress level down.

You are invited to use the **School Typing Program:**

1. Go to <https://buckingham-browne.typingclub.com/>
 - **Username:** first initial last name (example, msmith for Mary Smith)
 - **Password:** changeme
2. **Change your password** - tab, on left side of screen
3. After you change the password. Please click on **MS Assessment 1** and take the typing test. This test will require you to type a full paragraph of BB&N Responsible Use Policy. Once you are finished you will get a score. If you have reached the goal of 30 WPM with 90 percent accuracy, you do not need to continue.

If you have not reached your goal, you need to go back and practice touch typing:
