As you will see in this annual report, the BB&N community provided \$14.7M this year in support of our school. That is simply incredible, and I want to begin by thanking each and every one of you for your commitment to this incredible school. Simply put, we could not do it without you.

This year saw the return of some important traditions that define our community, including re-engaging in our global travel programs, getting back on the road for alumni events, bringing back the One School One World celebration, and honoring deserving faculty with chairs and instructorships. In addition, we brought forward new and exciting experiences, such as awarding a second round of innovation grants to faculty, hosting a regional conference about AI in Education, developing and staging an all-school arts festival, and playing games and holding practices on our extraordinary new Grove Street fields.


Day of Giving

BB&N celebrated its seventh annual Day of Giving in April. Every spring, our community comes together for this one-day event when we celebrate our combined support and pride for the school. Each gift made to The BB&N Fund is used to support our students in their pursuit of academic excellence so they may continue to be successful in all that they do—in the classroom, on the field, on the stage, or across the globe.

Parents of the Class of 2023 Raise \$1.5 Million and Establish The Class of 2023 Visiting Innovator Program

Thanks to the generosity of parents of the Class of 2023, a total of \$1.515 million was raised in support of BB&N's strategic initiatives. To recognize their generosity, The Visiting Innovator Program is being established and named for the class as part of the Innovation Endowment Fund component of the school's comprehensive campaign.

The Class of 2023 Visiting Innovator Program will fund a visiting innovator each year who will lead workshops and community and professional development sessions during the academic year. In future years, members of the Class of 2023 will have the opportunity to be a part of the selection process for the Visiting Innovator, providing a chance for them to stay engaged with their former classmates, the school, and the program.

The first Class of 2023 Visiting Innovator is Liza Talusan, Ph.D., an educator, facilitator, and strategic change partner for organizations, corporations, leadership teams, schools and individuals who are looking to build their skills in areas of diversity, equity, inclusion, justice, and leadership.

The author of *The Identity-Conscious Educator*, Dr. Talusan is leading four all-school professional development sessions with faculty and staff throughout this year, to support BB&N's collective capacity to become an even more inclusive school by understanding and embracing the identities of all members of the community.

Class of 2023 parents contributed more than \$1.5 million to BB&N in support of The BB&N Fund and campaign objectives, and to name the Class of 2023 Visiting Innovator Program.

New Destinations and Programs for Student Travel Draw Increased Interest and Opportunities

In the first year of international travel since the pandemic, an increased number of Middle and Upper School students took advantage of a number of travel opportunities, thanks in part to support from generous financial aid from spendable and endowed funds.

In 2023, students were able to travel to a variety of destinations to explore the countries' culture and language. As they have in the past, Upper School students traveled to France and Spain and had the opportunity for home stays, while the traditional Russian exchange program was adapted to visit countries along the Adriatic coast with ties to Russian language and culture.

A new Arabic program in Oman and Dubai provided an opportunity for students to be immersed in a different culture and practice their language skills, while Middle School students had a chance to explore Greece over spring break and Mexico this summer. Upper School students were also able to attend international Round Square conferences in England and Morocco, as well as a fall 2023 Round Square conference in Kenya.

\$158,700

Nearly \$159,000 was distributed last year to 41 students on financial aid to allow them to participate in travel programs and international Round Square conferences.

These experiences are life-changing for students and in many cases change their future paths.

“I benefited from this experience by learning more about Spanish culture and history. This added layer of understanding will enhance my study of Spanish back at BB&N and will allow me to be a more informed global citizen. **”**

“I have benefitted in multiple ways from this experience and have created new relationships with people that I hope will last me a lifetime. I've also found a new sense of self by making it through one of the most uncomfortable experiences of my life but being able to enjoy it greatly! **”**

“I think that it was different to travel as this type of global citizen.... It was a new experience for me and it taught me the importance of making lots of different friends in other places as it gives you a range of perspectives and cultures. **”**

“The trip has given me more of a desire to help others and be civically responsible. Seeing amazing things and cultures in a far-off place helped me to understand the responsibility that each and every one of us, as humans, have to our fellow people and all of humanity as a whole. We should be working to preserve these incredible cultures and the world they inhabit, and I think this trip helped crystallize that feeling for me. **”**




THE BB&N FUND BY YEAR 2019-2023





2022-2023 DISTRIBUTION OF EXPENSES*







Alum and Former Math Teacher Supports New Math Curriculum for Grades 6-8

For Lee Ginsburg Herbst '53—Buckingham alum and former Buckingham and BB&N math teacher—and her late husband Arthur Herbst, philanthropy has long offered the opportunity to inspire students and faculty in a subject about which they are deeply passionate.

More than ten years ago, the Herbsts established an endowed fund with the purpose of supporting extracurricular math initiatives such as the Middle School Girls' Math Collaborative. It is no surprise, then, that they jumped at the opportunity to be a part of a new chapter of math education at BB&N.

As part of the school's strategic plan for curriculum alignment for grades B-12, BB&N will be implementing Open Up Resources as the math curriculum for grades 6-8 beginning this school year. The goal of this change is to enhance students' critical thinking and problem-solving capabilities, align the approaches to curriculum and instruction between the Lower and Middle School campuses, and best prepare students for the Upper School math program.

The Herbsts' generous gift funded crucial professional development for this initiative by supporting the review, piloting, and selection processes for the new curriculum as well as initial faculty training.

Upper School Round Tables: Michael Chapman, Upper School Dean of Teaching and Learning

With the support of an Innovation Grant, Round Tables kicked off in September at the Upper School. In the words of project manager Michael Chapman, Round Tables aim to help faculty “break down the silos of departmentalization” and “come together in small interdisciplinary groups.... to discuss a particular topic, practice, or inquiry for the year” that directly enhances the student experience. Each Round Table, led by a faculty facilitator, will meet seven times throughout the academic year, culminating in an Adult Learning Showcase.

Upper School Serenity Room: Amani Abu Shakra, Upper School Arabic

This grant funded the transformation of the seating area of the Upper School faculty room into a Serenity Room where faculty and staff can utilize the space to prioritize their mental wellbeing. The space has been designed to allow faculty and staff to take breaks during the day to de-stress and recharge, as well as provide space to practice mindfulness and meditation.

“In keeping with the Upper School’s 2022-2023 goal of working ‘toward having all community members feel confident, connected, and cared for, both in and out of the classroom,’ as well as acknowledging the rising levels of stress among teachers. I started to reimagine the faculty room as a serene space and thus the Serenity Room idea was created.

I imagined it to be a space where faculty could come in at different times in the day, relax, chat with colleagues, sit in silence, or engage in a quick meditation or breathing exercise, and then return to classes or meetings energized and rested. With the support of the iGrant, the Upper School Serenity Room opened this fall and is now available to Upper School faculty and staff.”

Professional Development Opportunities for Faculty and Staff Support BB&N Priorities

BB&N faculty and staff continue to benefit from a variety of opportunities for personal and professional growth, thanks in part to the generosity of donors to The BB&N Fund, endowed and spendable funds.

In 2022-2023, BB&N provided nearly \$270,000 in funding for faculty and staff to participate in one or more voluntary professional development opportunities, including conferences and workshops on and off campus, as well as All-School professional days.

“Attending the American Educational Research Association conference means that I am able to collaborate with and learn from educators from around the world about educational lenses such as early childhood education. The international perspective of conferences like AERA helps me to rethink pedagogy and practice, allows me to deepen my practice, and to grow and evolve as an educator and a collaborator with the children at BB&N.”

In addition, **37 curriculum development grants totalling close to \$70,000 were awarded in summer 2023 to 80 faculty and staff**, many of whom collaborated with colleagues across campuses and disciplines to expand and enhance programs for their students.

In September, grant recipients presented summaries of their work during a “curriculum share” with their colleagues that offered invaluable opportunities for faculty and staff of different departments, disciplines, and campuses to identify throughlines across each others’ work.

Reflections from curriculum share participants identified a number of commonalities across the projects, including student-centered, inclusive, and identity-focused initiatives.

“Everyone’s work had an eye toward including people of color’s perspectives—from physics to English to history—ensuring that we aren’t just teaching a traditional dominant white narrative, while also acknowledging that this work takes time and effort and funding.”

“It is exciting to see the ways in which folks from [all campuses] are commonly thinking about ways to create inclusive practice and themes of diversity within our work!”

“Our new value of “inquiry” was represented in the work we are doing across campuses. Students are being respected and trusted to dig into complex, relevant issues and to develop new lenses for looking at the world.”

“I am continually impressed by how dedicated and committed our faculty and staff are in improving their curriculum in new and exciting ways that benefit our students and families.”

BB&N’s professional development budget also supported travel grants totalling \$43,000 to seven faculty and staff, enabling them to travel with their family and friends to destinations including Ireland, Spain, Costa Rica, South Korea, and Japan. These opportunities provided a variety of personal and professional experiences that will enrich their teaching and curricula.

“My family and I traveled to South Korea this summer where my husband and I were both born before we immigrated to the United States in our childhood. I appreciated anew the cultural differences between the East and the West and more specifically, between Korea and the United States. As an adult, I am doing the work of rediscovering and honoring the Korean part of my identity that I have had to shield and hide while growing up.

There are three initial ways that I will incorporate my learning and experiences into my practice. First, I feel reinvigorated to study more about art from different cultures, past and present, so that I can expand what I teach to our students. Second, as a teacher, advisor, and community member, I am even more motivated to approach my practice with humility, inquiry, appreciation, and kindness as I work with the diverse students and families that make up our community. And third, I feel more comfortable with the discomfort of ‘not knowing’ and the joyful release to say ‘I don’t know, but I’d like to learn more...’”
